Many people think it's safe to burn in the spring but it's actually one of the worst times to burn due to the dry, dead vegetation on the ground that can spark grass fires. Play it safe and take your brush up to 6" in diameter free of charge to our Portland landfill site open Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8:30 to 4:30 pm. While we don't require burn permits, any open air fire must be supervised at all times according to our Open Air Burning By-law.
