We have completed the water and wastewater servicing study for the Verona Housing Master Plan. The final study documents are now posted on the project page on engagefrontenac.ca for public comment.

Road Construction Season Underway

It's construction season! See our Road Closures and Construction page for planned road construction projects or engagefrontenac.ca for details on specific projects as we work to improve our roads:

- Bedford Rd: reconstruction of a 3.6 km section between Salmon Lake Rd and Desert Lake Rd to begin the first week of July until September
- Devil Lake Rd: reconstruction of a 6.6 km section from June to August
- Greenfield Rd: reconstruction of a 0.7 km section near the end of the road in June and July
- Kerr Rd: reconstruction of a 0.6 km section during the months of June and July
- Ormsbee Rd: reconstruction of a 2.7 km section from June until September
- Sydenham Lake Bridge and Dam Rehabilitation: work underway until August 2024. The road and sidewalk will be accessible at all times with occasional single-lane traffic
- Tom Watson Rd: reconstruction of a 0.6 km section during the months of June and July

Please help make it a safe summer by reducing speeds in construction zones, and obeying crews and traffic signs at all times.

Town Hall Expansion and Relocation

We're expanding our Town Hall in Sydenham at 4432 George Street and will be moving into temporary office space towards the end of July. The Town Hall and Council Chambers will be inaccessible during the expansion. Here is how you can find us:

- Our main reception and Treasury department will move next door to the Sydenham Library Community Room, 4412 Wheatley Street which will be unavailable for booking by community groups starting July 15. The library will remain open.
- Building and Planning will relocate to office space in the Storrington Centre, 3910 Battersea Rd. The Storrington Centre will still be available to community groups to book.
- Council and committee meetings will relocate to the Storrington Centre starting in September
- There is no impact to the Township's Public Services department located at 2490 Keeley Road.
