### Town Hall Municipal Offices Have Temporarily Moved

We're expanding our Town Hall in Sydenham at 4432 George Street and have moved into temporary office space. The Town Hall and Council Chambers will be inaccessible during the expansion. Here's how to find us and access services:

- The main **Reception and Treasury** department have relocated to the Sydenham Library Community Room at 4412 Wheatley St.
- The **Building and Planning** reception have relocated to the Storrington Centre administrative offices at 3910 Battersea Rd. The Storrington Centre will still be available for community groups to book.
- There is no impact to the Township's **Public Services** department located at 2490 Keeley Rd.
- **Council and Committee** meetings will relocate to the Storrington Centre starting in September.
